

Teach SouthEast – an Outstanding ITT provider (Ofsted 2018)

We are a proud Partner School of Teach SouthEast - an outstanding school-based initial teacher training provider (SCITT), with its base in Woking, established in 2013. Through partnership with a range of supportive schools in Surrey and surrounding areas, a high-quality, bespoke programme is delivered for aspiring primary and secondary teachers, training over 400 Trainees since its start.

Teach SouthEast is passionate about training and developing outstanding teachers of tomorrow and about meeting the employment needs of schools in the local area. Every year, at least two-thirds of the cohort gain employment in one of our twenty partner schools, with 100% of Trainees seeking a teaching job being employed in schools in the wider area.

Trainees are well-prepared through first-rate, nurturing placements which ensure that they gain substantial practical experience, developing their teaching skills by putting into practice their wide-ranging and expert training they receive.

Training is delivered in three main ways:

- Every Friday morning the whole cohort (of around 100 Trainees for Secondary and 15 for Primary), come together for General Professional Studies (GPS), where research-led and evidence-based pedagogy (such as managing behaviour and assessing learning) is taught by expert practitioners.
- Every Friday afternoon the Secondary cohort divides into Subject Hubs (in local Partner Schools) where a subject expert delivers high-quality subject-specific training.
- Monday - Thursday is spent with Trainees immersing themselves in school life, from teaching to tutor time, assemblies to extra-curricular activities. In-school training takes place with the subject-specific Mentor and more formally on a weekly basis with the SCITT Lead (the person in charge of all the Trainees in that school), ensuring that the training is linked to GPS and relevant to Trainees' needs.
