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Advanced Engineering Level 3 Apprenticeship Programme

- Engineering Technician Apprenticeship Standard following the Mechatronics Maintenance Technician route: beginning at Level 3. Three-year programme, starting Sept 2019
- Starting salary: £12,300 to £19,500 per year (£1,025 to £1,625 per month) dependant on age and location allowance (up to £133pm inner London and up to £283pm Outer London). Annual pay increases awarded plus benefits
- Salary on completion: minimum of £27,900 per year (£2,325 per month)
- Includes a 37-week residential course in year one in Blackburn and a six-week training course in year two
- Includes membership with the Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET)
