## Parents

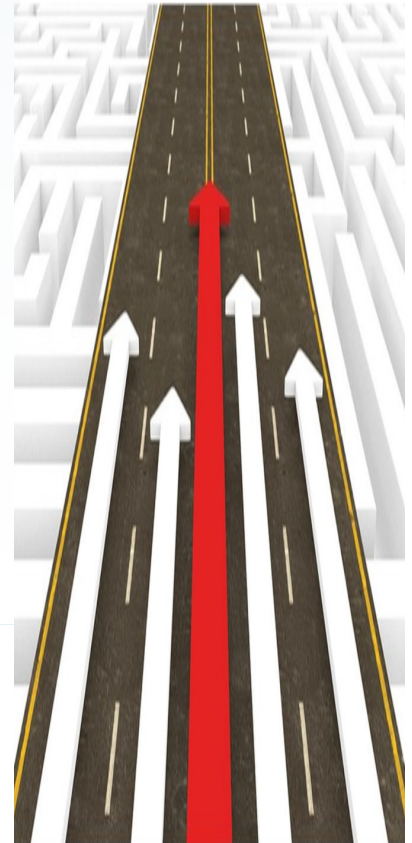

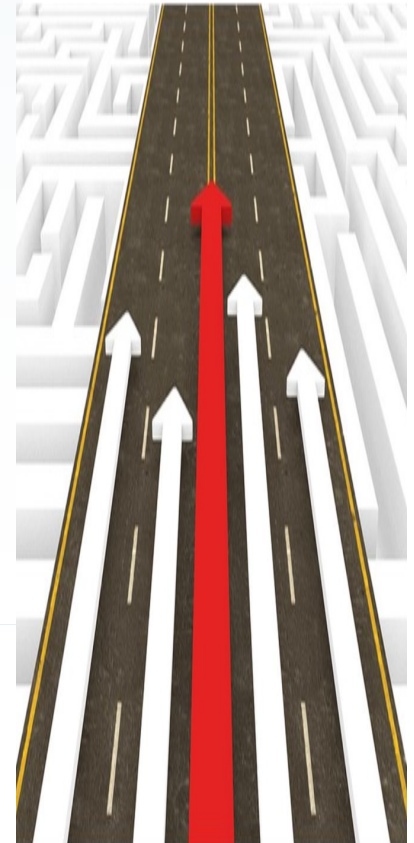
