YEAR 10 ART INTENT Students in Y10 are increasingly more independent in their learning, accessing more freedom with their artistic choices, and learn the responsibilities that come with this independence. They develop projects from a given theme, presenting a personal and meaningful response to it, realising intentions trough research, experimentations, record, and analysis. Initially, students exclusively look at the theme of Natural Forms, further develop their observational skills and working in depth with printing, watercolour, acrylic, oil and soft pastel, charcoal while looking at artists as Karl Blossfeldt, Georgia O'Keeffe, and Anna Mason. Then they choose a focus; Insects, Fruits and Veg, Animals, Human Body, Under the Water, Structures, etcetera; to develop their project and present a personal and meaningful response.
